The Author represents and warrants that (a) the Article is an original work, that it does not infringe the rights of others and that the Author has full authority to enter into this assignment and that the execution of this assignment does not conflict with other obligations or other contracts by which the Author is bound; (b) any portion of the Article consisting of prior works that have not fallen into the public domain and that are reproduced in the Article, such as excerpts, illustrations, tables or other borrowings from other works, has been reproduced with due credit and with any authorization that may be required therefore from any owner of copyright in such works; (c) the Article, or its equivalent, is not being considered, in whole or in part, for publication in any other journal, and has not been and will not be submitted, in whole or in part, to any other organization for initial publication; (d) that the Author is (check one option only):
